

Paula Tyer gave a recorded sworn statement to Detective Frank Pilewski on December 19, 2012 but it was not added to the SAO did not submit it into discovery until March 24, 2014. On May 16, 2013 Chief of Police Paul O'Connell told me that he confirmed with Detective Pilewski that the statement was sent to the SAO. However at that point in time it was not part of my file. On September 26, 2013 I sent Judge Siegel a letter telling him my lawyer did not have a copy of this statement.

I finally received a copy of this statement in January 2014 and I had it transcribed and filed it as Defendant's Reciprocal Discovery on March 18, 2014. I would like to know why it took over 15 months for this exculpatory witness statement to be filed. Please let me know the date this witness statement was sent to the SAO, the date it was transcribed and any other information concerning this document.
