## Halloween Night

My partner planned to be in the costume contest at the Alibi so we were standing near the right side of the stage where the stage steps were placed. During the 45 minutes or so that we were there, I eased my way right up to the stage to a small space between the steps and the right side of the stage. There was a rope barrier to my right which kept people from standing there.

On the stage about 15' to my left, near center stage, I saw two stage commentators, one of which was Michael Walters. I noted that Walters was not talking much which seemed odd for him. I had an unobstructed view of Walters, the entire right side of the stage and the people standing on the ground next to the right of the stage. One person in particular was standing on the ground and he caught my attention as he was wearing a white costume and was carrying a lit torch and a wooden cross. This man was later identified as Boyd Corbin.

I noted that Walters kept looking at Corbin and then took a few steps toward him. Walters ordered, "Put that torch out". Corbin did nothing but I couldn't tell if he had heard what Walters said or not due to the loud sounds. Walters took a few more steps toward him and again said "Put that torch out". Corbin was just standing there. He did not put the torch out nor did he try to stick it toward the stage or Walters. Walters then walked right up the edge of the stage and yelled, "I told you to put that damn torch out". As he said this he leaned out a bit to reach the torch, and grabbed it below the flame and above Corbin's right hand. Corbin was holding the cross in his left hand.

Walters blew on the torch but he was too far away to make it completely go out. So, he pulled it closer and blew again but it just flickered. Then, he pulled the torch toward him which also pulled Corbin closer to the stage. Walters bent forward to get even closer to the flame and blew on it. This time it went almost completely out. As Walters was bent forward, Corbin dropped his cross from his left hand and reached up and pulled Walter's wig off. Corbin stood there, torch in his right hand and Walter's wig in his left hand. Walters let go of the torch and used his hands to feel his bare head. After feeling that the wig was off, he got a look of anger on his face. He sat his buttocks on the edge of the stage and pushed off to the ground. Corbin did not pull him off the stage! He could not have reached his arms to pull him off as the stage was about shoulder height and he had the torch in one hand and the wig in the other.

When Walters got off the stage Corbin dropped the wig and started backing up. Walters still had both his high heels on at this point and he approached Corbin while cursing at him and he yelled, "Do you know how much that damn wig cost?" Corbin still had the torch in his right hand until Walters started throwing punches at him. Corbin then dropped the torch and threw some punches back. Both fell to the

ground with Walters on top of Corbin. Then Walters stood up and this allowed Corbin the chance to stand up. As Corbin was standing up Walters drew back his left leg (still had the heels on) and tried to kick Corbin. He missed and this action caused him to fall toward his right side. I heard a popping sound as he hit the pavement. Both his high heels came off. Corbin was about 10' away and did not approach him in any way. Within seconds, 2 security men approached Walters and helped him up. Walters looked back at the stage and told them to get his wig. It was still next to the stage but they did not go get it. One of the men did pick up Walter's high heeled shoes. They had their arms around Walters to support him as he walked barefoot into the crowd. I left to find my partner and tell her what happened.
